GENERAL ORDER ASSIGNING CIVIL AND CRIMINAL ACTIONS


In accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 137 and the agreement of the judges affected hereby, it is ORDERED that, effective immediately, all civil and criminal actions which are filed shall be assigned to individual judges of this district in the proportions listed below:

| DISTRICT JUDGE | CASELOAD |
|--------------------------------|---------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| CHIEF JUDGE JOHN HANNAH, JR. | Civil = 20% of Tyler & 90% of Lufkin Criminal = Same percentages as civil |
| JUDGE RICHARD A. SCHELL | Civil = 36% of Beaumont & 10% of Sherman Criminal = Same percentages as civil |
| JUDGE THAD HEARTFIELD | Civil = 37% of Beaumont & 10% of Lufkin Criminal = Same percentage as civil |
| JUDGE DAVID FOLSOM | Civil = 90% of Texarkana & 20% of Marshall Criminal = 100% of Texarkana |
| JUDGE T. JOHN WARD | Civil = 80% of Marshall & 10% of Texarkana Criminal = 100% of Marshall |
| JUDGE LEONARD DAVIS | Civil = 30% of Tyler, 35% of Sherman, 100% of Paris Criminal = Same percentages as civil |
| SENIOR JUDGE WILLIAM M. STEGER | Civil = 50% of Tyler Criminal = Same percentage as civil |
| SENIOR JUDGE HOWELL COBB | Civil = 27% of Beaumont Criminal = Same percentage as civil |
| SENIOR JUDGE PAUL BROWN | Civil = 55% of Sherman Criminal = Same percentage as civil |

This order supercedes General Order 01-18 and all previous general orders assigning civil and criminal actions.
