By direction of the full Court, meeting in executive session on Wednesday, January 8, 1986,

It is hereby ORDERED that the General Order concerning the assignment of civil actions, dated July 12, 1985, be amended in regard to the percentages and assignment of such actions filed in the Beaumont Division only. The revised percentages and assignments of civil actions shall be as follows:

Beaumont Division

Civil Actions

Judge Howell Cobb	35%
Judge Joseph J. Fisher	35%
Judge Sam B. Hall	20%
Judge Paul N. Brown	10%


It is further ORDERED that all asbestos-related actions, both those presently on file and those filed in the future in the Beaumont Division, be removed from the calendars of the judges to whom they are now assigned and placed on a common docket, with Judge Joe J. Fisher as the supervising judge of such docket, except for those actions which may be within the scope of Civil Action No. M-84-193-CA, pending in the Marshall Division of the Court.

It is further ORDERED that the Beaumont civil actions currently assigned to Judge Robert M. Parker and remaining after the multi-party asbestos-related actions have been removed to a common docket be reassigned by lot, to the remaining judges assigned to the Beaumont Division, in accordance with the percentages set forth above.

It is further ORDERED that this General Order shall take effect on the opening of business on January 13, 1986.
