STANDING ORDER

It is

ORDERED that all removal petitions filed by Federal Savings and Loan Insurance Corporation (FSLIC), as a receiver, may be limited to the allegation of claims against the institution in receivership, and it shall not be necessary to attach, as exhibits, any part of the file in state court relating to such removed action; provided, however, that FSLIC shall cause to be filed in this court, at its own expense, the entire state court file (except for discovery matters) within thirty days of request by the court for its production; and further provided that such file shall be filed upon the request of any interested party, if such party has first had and obtained leave of the court to make the request. It is further

ORDERED that FSLIC shall attach a copy of this order to any future petition for removal, together with a list of all attorneys involved in the action being removed, and each attorney's address, telephone number, and party or parties represented by him or her.
