REAPPOINTMENT OF UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE

It appearing that the current term of office of United States Magistrate Harry W. McKee will expire on August 5, 1990; and

It appearing that the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts has voted to continue the magistrate's position for an additional eight-year term of office; and

The judges of this court, desiring to consider the reappointment of incumbent magistrate, Harry W. McKee, accordingly, did appoint a Merit Selection Panel to assist the judges in their determination as to the reappointment of the incumbent; and


It appearing that the Panel did review the incumbent's performance in office as a magistrate and did unanimously recommend the incumbent for reappointment;

NOW THEREFORE, the judges of this court, after due consideration of the report of the Panel, unanimously concur in the reappointment of Harry W. McKee to a new term in the position of United States Magistrate for the Eastern District of Texas, effective August 6, 1990, with his duty station being designated

as Tyler, Texas.
