
ORDER

The Marshal's Service is directed that in all courtrooms of the Eastern District of Texas procedures shall be adopted to exclude the carrying of firearms by anyone other than Marshals and Court Security Officers. Further procedures shall also be adopted to eliminate cameras, electronic devices such as recorders and lap-top computers from the courtrooms.

Federal and state law enforcement officers will be allowed to retain firearms while transporting prisoners to Federal courtrooms. Law enforcement officers while not engaged in transporting or handling prisoners in a Federal courtroom will check their weapons with United States Marshals Service personnel or Court Security Officers.

This General Order supersedes General Order No. 92-1 dated the 7th day of January 1992.
