**General Order:** Authorized duties of the part-time United States Magistrate Judge at Sherman.


The part-time magistrate judge at Sherman is authorized to perform any and all duties authorized by local rules or general orders of this court to be performed by the full-time magistrate judges of the district.

Pursuant to the Guidelines for the Trial of Civil Cases by a Part-Time Magistrate (Judge), issued by the Judicial Council of the Fifth Circuit on February 22, 1990, the court certifies as follows:

1. That a full-time magistrate judge is not reasonably available to conduct civil consent cases under the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(c) at Sherman; and
- 2, no full-time magistrate judge is stationed at Sherman; and
3. a part-time magistrate judge is stationed at Sherman and is available to try civil cases without undue interference with the magistrate judge's other duties and no actual conflict of interest or appearance of impropriety will occur due to the magistrate judge's practice of law.
