
In order to assist in Judge Hall's speedy recovery by relieving him of the burden of his docket the Court enters the following temporary orders:

Parker.
2. The remaining Marshall civil docket is assigned to the Honorable William M. Steger.
3. The Texarkana civil docket is assigned to the Honorable Howell Cobb.

The assignments contained in this order are temporary and shall be in effect only so long as is necessary for Judge Hall to regain his health and resume his duties.
