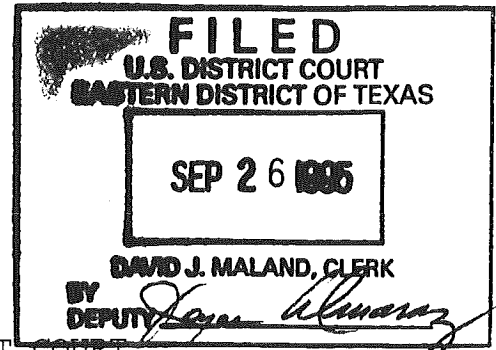


General Order No. 95- 17

AMENDED ORDER REGARDING COURTHOUSE SECURITY

At the direction of the judges of the court, General Order 94-39 is hereby **AMENDED** [note: additional language appears in redline text]. The Marshals Service is directed that in all federal courthouses and off-site federal court facilities in the Eastern District of Texas (except for off-site U. S. Probation facilities), procedures shall be adopted to exclude the carrying of weapons by anyone other than U. S. Marshals, Court Security Officers, Federal Protective Service Officers and law officers who have detainees or evidence in custody. Further procedures shall also be adopted by the Marshals Service to prohibit persons other than federal court and U. S. Attorney's Office personnel from bringing cameras and electronic devices such as video and audio tape recorders, laptop computers and personal pagers into the courthouses, unless granted permission by the presiding judge in the case.
