Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 83(b) and Local Rule CV-83(c), the following regulation of practice applies in any pending civil case assigned to the undersigned judge:

**JCB-CV-10. FORMAT OF FILINGS**


Each page of a document subject to Local Rule CV-10 must bear a page number, starting with 1 on the first page. Roman numerals are not permitted. The page number must be centered in the bottom margin of each page.

*Explanatory notes:*

This rule is meant to ensure that the practice of pin citing the page numbering assigned by ECF to a party's filing does not conflict with the party's own page numbering.

This rule applies to all filings subject to Local Rule CV-10. Despite that rule's title, it applies not just to "pleadings" (those listed in Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 7), but to all court filings except for preexisting documentary exhibits and attachments. Also excepted from this standing order are preexisting forms, such as those provided by the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts.
